Roles and responsibilities

Board and committee meetings

- Attend regularly scheduled board meetings and annual meeting in November
- Schedule and conduct Lake Management Committee meetings
- Prepare and present a monthly report of committee activities

Budget

- Work with the Treasurer to define an annual budget
- Record all project costs and summarize them in monthly reports

Other responsibilities:

- Define reasonable goals and objectives for the year
 - o Recommend lake shoreline stabilization treatments
 - Identify pre-concept level projects to reduce point source pollutants loadings through stormwater best practices, especially green infrastructure improvements
 - Develop an aquatic plant management plan that targets the reduction of invasive species and promote native plant diversity
 - Work with IDNR and the LLLMC for protocols to maintain a healthy fishery
- Monitor and report progress regarding goals, objectives, projects
 - o Conduct lake inspections to include inlets, dam, spillway and shoreline
 - Work with contracted aquatics company to survey and assess lake conditions on a routine basis during the season. Collaborate on interventions, treatments and measurable anticipated success through observations and instrumentation
 - Maintain regular water quality reports:
 - Spraying reports: Dissolved oxygen, TDS, TSS, water temps at surface and below
 - Secchi levels and Tier 2 water sample collections
 - Stream Inlet Monitoring Project: TDS, conductivity, water temps, and flora and fauna observations, growth, cycles and nuisance to the environment
 - Documentation of shoreline erosion inclusive of the inlets
 - Reporting herbicide and algicide treatments and applications chemical spraying (maintenance)
 - Water sampling results from Lake County Health Dept. after significant rain
- Utilize resources and establish a liaison(s) for LLPOA and Lake Management Committee
 - o Identify grant and other funding strategies at the local, state, and federal levels
 - o Set up and establish training programs where appropriate and applicable
 - o Bull Creek and Bull Brook Watershed Planning Council
