Native Trees for the Future

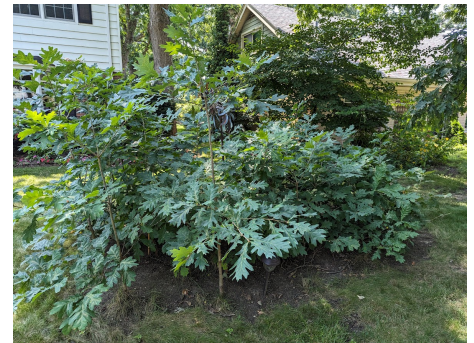
- **Loch Lomond is an Oak & Hickory forest, with many trees over 100 or 200 years old! We are fortunate!**
- Many residents have planted the next generations of trees over the past 70 years, but there are still more older trees than younger ones.
- **We are 1-2 tree generations behind planting the trees for the future! We need to plant for the next generations of trees now!**
- If you find a **volunteer tree** (pops up naturally and unexpectedly) you may need to take care to support it, place a wire cage around it to protect it from animals and accidental mowing. Within a few years you may develop the next generation of trees!



Plant These

Trees

- Swamp White Oak - *Quercus bicolor*
- Bur Oak - *Quercus macrocarpa*
- Northern Red Oak - *Quercus rubra*
- American Basswood - *Tilia americana*
- Red Maple - *Acer rubrum*
- Blue Beech or Musclewood - *Carpinus caroliniana*
- Eastern Redbud - *Cercis canadensis*
- Kentucky Coffeetree - *Gymnocladus dioica*
- Bald Cypress - *Taxodium distichum*
- Hickory - *Carya spp*
- Shagbark Hickory - *Carya ovata*
- Eastern White Pine - *Pinus strobus*
- Northern White-Cedar - *Thuja occidentalis*
- Eastern Redcedar - *Juniperus virginiana*
